I, the undersigned, understand that Hawaii law (Act 249 1994 Hawaii Legislative Session, effective June 29, 1994) limits the civil liability of persons sponsoring equine (horse, pony, hinny) activities. I understand that there are inherent risks of injury, including death, when participating in an equine activity with horses, which risks include, but are not limited to, (1) the propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury or death to persons on or around them; (2) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to things such as sounds, sudden movements, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (3) hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (4) collisions with other equines or objects; and (5) the potential negligence of another participant, such as failing to maintain control over the equine, or not acting within the participants ability. Knowing and understanding the risks of participating in an equine activity, including injury and death to my person and damage to my personal property, I expressly choose to assume these risks. Further, on behalf of myself, my heirs, successors, representatives, and assigns, I hereby unconditionally release any and all claims and causes of action against the equine activity sponsor, Hawaii Horse Owners, Inc., and its / their officers, directors, representatives, and show personnel, for any injury, including death, and for any damages to my personal property, which I may incur as a result of my participation in this equine activity. If the undersigned is the parent, guardian or representative of any minor participating in this equine activity, the undersigned agrees to indemnify the Hawaii Horse Owner's Association (including its / their above-described related persons and entities) from any and all claims and causes of action brought by or on behalf of said minor at any time. I also agree to abide by all rules and regulations set forth by the Hawaii Horse Owner's Association.

I THE UNDERSIGNED hereby Release the Hawai'i Tourism Authority, the County of Hawai'i, HHO and its employees, agents, contractors, etc. for the irrevocable right and permission to use, publish and exhibit any photographs, videotapes, media, etc. that is taken of me at the Pana'ewa Stampede Rodeo. I Release the above from any claim or any liability in connection with the use of the photo or media taken.

For Pana'ewa Stampede Rodeo
February 16, 17 & 18, 2019

Thank you for your interest in being the Pana'ewa Stampede Rodeo Queen. The Rodeo Queen position is obtained by earning Credits through the sale of Rodeo Tickets or getting Rodeo Sponsors. The Rodeo Queen Contest begins as of November 10, 2018.

Queen Contestants sell Tickets for \$8.00 (will be \$10.00 at the gate). One Credit will be earned per ticket sold.

One Credit is earned per \$10.00 donation received from a business or individual sponsor. Sponsors MUST be new sponsors and NOT those that were sponsors last year (unless you/your family obtained them in prior years or the sponsor makes a statement requesting to be your specific sponsor).

Contestant receiving the most Credits will win and be the Rodeo Queen. Minimum of 50 Credits must be earned to qualify as the Rodeo Queen or First Runner-Up.

Contestants are to turn in all, or the majority, of the ticket money prior to being issued more Rodeo Tickets.

Contestants are to turn in a photo of themselves and a small write up for the Rodeo Program no later than February 1, 2019.

Contestants will turn in all Sponsorship/Donation money and the names and contact information of the sponsor to be printed in the program no later than February 1, 2019.

Contestants will turn in all ticket money and their remaining tickets by February , 2019.

Contestant will be paid \$1.00 per ticket sold after they pay in the full \$8.00 per ticket sold. Payment will be made at the Rodeo.

Contestants can have other people help them sell tickets and get donations. Contestants cannot 'donate' their Credits to other contestants.

At the Rodeo, the Queen/Princess must be dressed in appropriate western attire while on the Rodeo grounds throughout the Rodeo Weekend. Long-sleeve western shirts or official Rodeo T-Shirt must be long enough to be tucked in at all times. The Queen/Princess sash should be worn when not competing in the Rodeo or working in such a manner that would not be good for the sash (chute, catch-pen, etc.).

All Queen Contestants are to be present to be in the Grand Entry at the start of each Rodeo. Following the Grand Entry on Saturday, they are to gather for the 'official' Rodeo Photo.

Rodeo Queen and First Runner Up are to be available throughout the Rodeo and on Monday for the presentation of the Buckles and Saddles.

All Rodeo Queen Contestants and/or their legal guardians must sign the HHO Waiver prior to taking place in any HHO Events.
